2018 CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP RULES

PLEASE READ...VERY IMPORTANT!

1. Every round of a particular club championship bracket will be afforded 3 weeks to complete a match. This is a reasonable period of time to play a match and matches that aren't finished on time will no longer be tolerated.(Playing matches early if possible is allowed.)
2. Matches not completed by the completion date will be subject to an immediate coin flip with the winner of the flip moving on. If one party believes the other party is at fault and is causing the majority of the scheduling issue, he may then call for Men's Division intervention. The Men's Division Committee will only intervene when a party makes a formal complaint in writing at least one week prior to the deadline. Complaints must be handed to pro shop or emailed directly to the head professional. Any complaints, no matter how valid they are, will not be heard within one week of the deadline. Chair will consult with involved parties, head professional and committee and will make a ruling ASAP and notify those involved.
3. All players that enter a club championship tournament must be prepared to play their final on Hump Griggs Champions Day (Sunday, August 19th). Matches that can't be played due to players being in multiple finals must be prepared to play their match the Saturday prior to Hump Griggs Day. Singles matches take precedent to team matches. Scratch matches take precedent to handicap. Open divisions take precedent to senior matches.
4. Injuries or unforeseen schedule conflicts that affect match play will be reviewed by the Club Championship Chair and Men's Division Committee. Rulings will be made on a case by case judgment. Injury appeals must be in writing and submitted to head professional via written letter or email.
